#### **An Easter Celebration for You**

The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. By the Lord has this been done, it is marvelous in our eyes. This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. – Psalm 118:22-24

Recently, at the dentist office of all places, I met someone who was overjoyed about having gone to church the past Sunday. When she overheard that I

was a pastor she just couldn't stop herself from sharing with me. "It's been years since I last went to my church, and finally on Sunday I decided to go. It felt so good, really like I had never been gone. I don't know why it had been so long, but it feels like new life for me." I was soon rushed to the back for my appointment and never heard what church it was she attended, but I suppose that really doesn't matter. What matters is the awareness that God is here, that you're always included with the people of God,

that there is a place for you, and that the Easter good news is most definitely an invitation to rebirth and new life for everyone.

Whenever we gather to worship on a Sunday morning, we gather because the tomb was discovered empty on a Sunday morning and because the news that Christ

was risen from the dead was first shared on a Sunday morning. Sunday morning is for new life and knowledge that death is defeated forever. Yes, that's the message of Easter Sunday, and will be the message on March 31, but it's also the underlying reality for our worship every Sunday, even during the Season of Lent. We come to worship to praise God and to seek his forgiveness. In worship we hear the

gospel message that no pit is too deep, no shadow too dark, no distance too far to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

In some ways every time we worship should be like a first time; like a reunion that's been a long time coming. It's the father running toward his long-lost son. It's the wonder of another dawn. It's new life and a new beginning. The lessons of Lent, the power of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the suffering of his Passion, the glory of the Cross,

and the confusion of the empty tomb all invite us to enter the story and know that the Easter celebration is for all of us: it is for you.

Come to where you are always welcome.

Rejoice always! Pastor Tony

services. This beautiful setting breaks into our soul with the music and prayers that expressed our hope in Christ.




## Lenten Service Opportunity

#### In the Spotlight

This month's "In the Spotlight" book review is presented by Pat Brogan, be sure to check out the Library's featured display on **March 10**.

My recommendation is not just one book, but a series by Bodie Thoene.

It is the Zion Covenant series: Vienna Prelude, Prague Counterpoint, Munich Signature, Jerusalem Interlude, Danzig Passage, and Warsaw Requiem. The series follows Jewish people through the German takeovers in Europe. If you like historical fiction, and especially WWII literature, I highly recommend this series, but read the books in order (they are numbered). This author also has a number of other historical series, and all are very well written. You will find them in the bookcase near the door in the church library.





#### **HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE**

#### Palm Sunday, March 24 (8:30 & 10:30am)

Services will begin with the story of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and the blessing of palm branches. Members of the congregation will share the Passion Story while the whole assembly sings songs that reflect the events.

#### Maundy Thursday, March 28 (7:00pm)

We will recall Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples and his New Commandment to love one another. The service ends in darkness with the stripping of the altar, propelling us to contemplate the sufferings of Christ.

#### Good Friday, March 29 (12:00 & 7:00pm)

These services of Light and Darkness move us to walk with Christ through his Passion as told in John's Gospel. As candles are extinguished, we ponder how Christ's unity with our suffering and death is made complete on the cross. The Bidding Prayer and final meditation upon the cross grounds us in his salvation path.

#### Easter Sunday, March 31 (6:30, 8:30 & 10:30am)

The tomb is empty! We gather to celebrate Christ's victory over death and the grave. United with Christ in death we are also united in his resurrection triumph. Our Sunrise Service at 6:30 begins in darkness and recognizes that this is the night death was defeated and Christ rose from the grave. All the services will be grounded in the Easter Story from Mark's Gospel and include music that sings praises to God and shares the news that Christ is risen!




