Talking with Myself

I got to talking with myself the other day. Here's some of the highlights:

You're looking busy, is there anything going on at church in September?

Well, yes there is. "God's Work. Our Hands" Sunday is September 8. We have four projects planned for here and throughout the community. After the late service we will have lunch and then get to work. That day we're also starting a new year of Kids Connect for students 5th grade and younger. Beginning on September 8, they will start upstairs at 10:30 am every Sunday and come in for worship near the end for communion and the Children's Message. Confirmation kicks off for 7th and 8th graders with an orientation on September 4. Youth Connect for students 6th grade and up will start this month as well. Of course there is a full slate of WELCA circles, Young at Heart, Men's

Group, dart ball, Second Harvest all happening too, just to name a few. We host a memorial service on September 7, a wedding on September 14, and "Lutheran's on the Move" leaves on September 28 for Virginia.

I've noticed that you have Bonhoeffer on the brain. Really, how is some old theologian relevant to what we do at Our Savior's today?

The staff and Board have been discerning our purpose and vision for the last several months. We can learn so much from Bonhoffer's teachings because it's grounded in Jesus. For example, we are of course called to love one another when we live in Christian community. But what makes that love unique and powerful here at Our Savior's is that we are called to love each other with spiritual love. This is a love that does not make demands on others; trying to intimidate them, control them, or make them in our own image. In Christian community we love our sisters and we love our brothers for exactly who they are. They belong to Christ and not to you.

What are you getting ready for Tuesday morning's weekly Staff Meeting?

I'm thinking of getting bagels again. I'm just so grateful for all of them. Kellie Carrier and Molly Rosenbloom have been their positions for just a few months, and they've already accomplished so much in the ministries to our children, youth, and families. Kellie's leadership led a successful Good Shepherd Sunday program last spring and a fantastic VBS last month. (continues on page 2)
